

## 2023-2024 Student Budget Independent or Dependent Student Living Off Campus

## **Other Costs:**

<u>Federal Loan Fees</u>: Federal loan fees are automatically added to the cost of attendance upon acceptance of the loan. Currently 1% of the loan amount requested.
