- Three hundred and fifty elementary students were bussed in for two performances of A Case of Missing Hot Dogs
- DMACC students acted in an Ingersoll Children's Theatre show, Wolf's Breath and Pig Tales. as part of a cooperative venture between the Ingersoll Dinner Theatre and DMACC.
- DMACC students acted in two productions, *Barefoot in the Part and The Dinner Party*, as part of a cooperative venture between Ankeny Community Theatre and DMACC. *The Dinner Party* was guest directed by Steve Poole, a Drama Workshop Director.
- The Woman in White, an old-fashioned melodrama, was performed at Living History Farms and the Iowa State Fair.

#### **Community Outreach and Public Relations:**

- Groups of DMACC students directed by Judy Hauser have performed at Art in the Park, The Two Rivers Festival, Beaverdale Days, Drake Fest, and the Des Moines Teacher's Convention.
- Casts have performed select scenes at the Main and South Side Libraries.
- DMACC students have assisted Judy Hauser in creative dramatic workshops at Yale-Jamaica-Bagley, Stuart-Menlo, Edmunds Fine Arts Academy, the Des Moines Community Playhouse, and the Metro Arts After School Program.
- DMACC students have performed scenes for the Riches to Share Program and the Westminster Presbyterian Church Senior Citizen's Group.
- Two DMACC students, responding to a casting call from Iowa Public Television, interpreted literature for the TV program *Living in Iowa*.
- The DMACC Drama Department was contacted by various commercial and civic organizations including the Botanical Center, the Hotel Fort Des Moines, Mr. Bulky, Camp Sunnyside, soliciting students for drama-related activities.
- The DMACC Drama Department was also received calls from around theatre organizations around the Des Moines area seeking young adult actors for their productions.
