Transfer Pathway Associate in Arts Degree (AA): Social & Behavioral Sciences/ Human Services / Social Work

If you are planning on transferring to a four-year college/university, you may complete freshman and sophomore requirements at Des Moines Area Community College. If you would like to study at a four year institution in a major such as (i.e. Psychology, Sociology, Social Work, etc.) the Social & Behavioral Pathway provides you with core courses that transfer to any institution. Since requirements vary for specific programs and four year institutions, you should become familiar with the specific course requirements of the four-year institution and/or major to which they are considering for transfer.

AA Degree Requirements

To Receive an AA degree, students must:

- A. Maintain a 2.0 grade point average on all work applicable to the AA degree. (core courses)
- B. Earn a minimum of 1/3 of the semester credit hours applicable to the degree being pursued at DMACC No more than 43 transfer semester credit hours may be applied toward the degree.
- C. Complete a minimum of 64 semester credit hours.
- D. Included at least 46 semester credit hours of Core courses:
 - Communications 9 credits
 - Social & Behavioral Sciences 9 credits
 - Math & Sciences 9 credits
 - Humanities 9 credits
 - Distributed Requirements 10 credits
- E. Include at least 18 credit hours of elective credit.
 - 1. Students may include 16 semester credit hours of vocational/technical credit.
 - 2. Students may have up to 8 semester credit hours of Independent Study Courses; up to 4 semester credit hours of Independent Study may be earned in any single semester.
- F. Complete **3 semester credit hours to satisfy the Diversity Requirement** with a minimum grade of "C". The Diversity Requirement does not increase the number of credits required for graduation. The course used to fulfill the Diversity Requirement may also be used to fulfill 3 credits of Core requirements in Communications, Social & Behavior Sciences, Humanities or Distributed Requirements, providing the diversity course is listed as fulfilling Core requirements in Communications, Social & Behavioral Sciences or the Humanities. If the course does not fall under any of the Core groups, the course used to fulfill the Diversity Requirement may count as an elective.

Courses that satisfy the Diversity Requirement at Des Moines Area Community College may or may not satisfy diversity requirements at other academic institutions. If you are planning to transfer, you should contact your transfer institution to verify the transferability of courses. This open AA plan is designed to meet transferability to "most" institutions without identifying a major or area of concentration.
